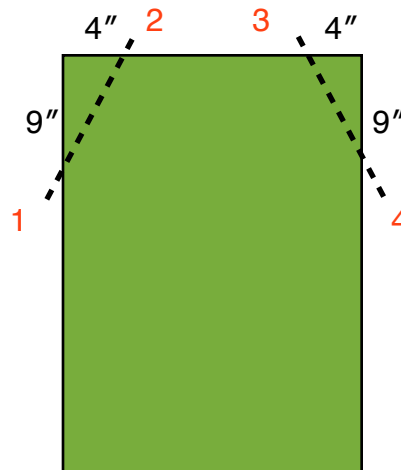


TEA TOWEL APRON

This apron is made from a plain tea towel and is super easy to make.

You will need a plain or light coloured tea towel size approximately 28" x 20".

Measure and cut off top corners as shown. Using a rotary cutter and ruler gives a nice straight cut.



Turn under these angled edges by $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press. Then turn under again by $1\frac{1}{2}$ " and press. Stitch this folded-over edge to leave a channel which will be for the straps to be threaded through.

For straps

Cut three lengths of fabric 42" x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " and join together on short edges to make one long strip. Place right sides together along length of strip and sew together $\frac{1}{4}$ " from raw edges. Continue the sewing along one end of the strap.

Turn strip through and press. Turn raw edges of final end inside, press and hand slip stitch end neatly.

The strap will thread through channel from 1 to 2 then leave enough strap to loop over head before threading through channel at 3 through to 4. Level out strap ends to be equal.

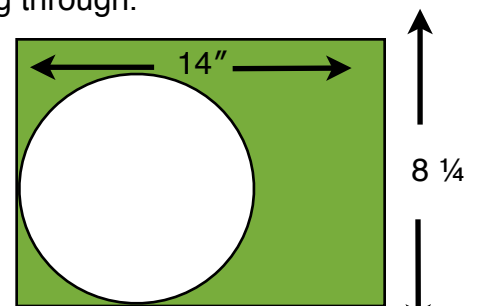
To make pocket

Cut a piece of fabric 14" x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ". Fold in half right sides together so that fabric measures 14" x $8\frac{1}{4}$ ". Lay a dinner plate as shown on both lower corners and draw around to curve of these two corners.

Sew around all sides (except the folded side) leaving a 2" gap for turning through.

Turn through and press.

Position pocket on apron. Place lower edge of pocket 2" from lower edge of apron and centre. Sew in place around all edges (except top edge) close to the folded edges of fabric.



Sew a vertical line of stitching from top to bottom of pocket at centre to create two separate sections in pocket.

Your tea towel apron is now complete.
